ART & ME Programming

The following three programs are focused on the specific artists Picasso, Chagall, and the Canadian Group of Seven. Each program has been developed by fully accredited York Region Board of Education teacher Lesli Fisher who also holds a degree in Fine Arts.

4 sessions – 90 minutes each - \$20 / student

Class minimum 20 students / maximum 30

(Class sizes outside these parameters may affect the rate charged.)

Picasso & Me Suggested Class Level – Gr. 5/6

Chagall & Me Suggested Class Level – Gr. 6/7

Group of Seven & Me Suggested Class Level – Gr. 7/8

The following “Art & Me” programs are examples of classes structured to follow the York Board of Education official Visual Arts Curriculum.

Individual sessions approximately 90 minutes and can include a short tour of the Arts Centre’s Main Gallery to view the current exhibit if desired.

Most single sessions are \$5.00 to \$6.00 / student

Class minimum of 20 and maximum of 30 students

(Class sizes outside of these parameters may affect the rate charged.)

Clay Sculpture Students create a clay sculpture focusing on texture (Note to teacher: may be a one day or a two part class if students return to paint their works).

Soapstone Necklace Using stone donated by Canadian sculptor David Ruben, students of all ages enjoy the art of carving.

Impressionism Students study a variety of landscape paintings by several different painters including Monet and Van Gogh and then create their own landscape using acrylic paint. Teachers may also request a particular picture, or other artist to be studied.

Sculpted Head 3 session class using paper mache
Class One: build form and 1st layer, Class Two: 2nd layer and sculpted details (ears, nose, hair, etc.) Class Three: paint finished head. This project can focus on a variety of different styles from classical Greek busts to animal heads.
