# Georgina Arts Centre & Gallery

The GAC is a unique art venue with a Public Gallery (featuring over 10 exhibitions yearly), a Coffee House, a Gallery Shoppe and a Native Gallery. The Centre is a teaching facility that offers various art classes, workshops, spring & summer camps for children and more. The Arts Centre works with local groups and schools to help with education and hands-on experiences.



## Educational Program

All of the GAC school programming is curriculum based and very flexible in adapting to your classroom requirements. We specifically address the requirements laid out in the Ministry of Education and Training "Ontario Curriculum for The Arts".

For instance, if you require a project based field trip based on the study of the Canadian Inuit for a grade 5/6 split history class, we might suggest a soapstone carving session where students design and carve their own necklace.



Or, you may need to study grade 8 Canadian geography. How better to understand the environment than through the work of the Group of Seven artists and creating a pen and watercolour masterpiece based on their paintings?

Sculpting is a specific requirement example in the Grade Two curriculum.

Come to the GAC and create a three-dimensional work in clay that communicates the students feeling regarding a familiar topic (ie. Family). We know that busing is an expensive proposition for all schools and to this end we suggest working with other facilities in Georgina to make your day trip a worthwhile and enjoyable experience. In the fall and spring you may wish to combine a visit with the GAC along with a visit to the Georgina Pioneer Museum.

The Red Barn Theatre occasionally has a children's program in the spring and the GAC would be happy to create an art project prior to the afternoon performance. Another destination may be to go swimming or skating at one of Georgina's facilities and then come to the GAC to eat lunch and have an art class. A great way to beat the winter blaahs!
